

## Chapter 2

### Page 28

**Judges 2:19** And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, *that* they returned, and corrupted *themselves* more than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them, and to bow down unto them; they ceased not from their own doings, nor from their stubborn way.

**1 Kings 14:22-24** **22**And Judah did evil in the sight of the LORD, and they provoked him to jealousy with their sins which they had committed, above all that their fathers had done. **23**For they also built them high places, and images, and groves, on every high hill, and under every green tree. **24**And there were also sodomites in the land: *and* they did according to all the abominations of the nations which the LORD cast out before the children of Israel.

**2 Chronicles 33:2-5** **2**But did *that which* was evil in the sight of the LORD, like unto the abominations of the heathen, whom the LORD had cast out before the children of Israel. **3**For he built again the high places which Hezekiah his father had broken down, and he reared up altars for Baalim, and made groves, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served them. **4**Also he built altars in the house of the LORD, whereof the LORD had said, In Jerusalem shall my name be for ever. **5**And he built altars for all the host of heaven in the two courts of the house of the LORD.

**2 Chronicles 34:2-7** **2**And he did *that which* was right in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the ways of David his father, and declined *neither* to the right hand, nor to the left. **3**For in the eighth year of his reign, while he was yet young, he began to seek after the God of David his father: and in the twelfth year he began to purge Judah and Jerusalem from the high places, and the groves, and the carved images, and the molten images. **4**And they brake down the altars of Baalim in his presence; and the images, that *were* on high above them, he cut down; and the groves, and the carved images, and the molten images, he brake in pieces, and made dust *of them*, and strowed *it* upon the graves of them that had sacrificed unto them. **5**And he burnt the bones of the priests upon their altars, and cleansed Judah and Jerusalem. **6**And *so did he* in the cities of Manasseh, and Ephraim, and Simeon, even unto Naphtali, with their mattocks round about. **7**And when he had broken down the altars and the groves, and had beaten the graven images into powder, and cut down all the idols throughout all the land of Israel, he returned to Jerusalem.

**Mark 5:2-5** **2**And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit, **3**Who had *his* dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains: **4**Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any *man* tame him. **5**And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones

**Mark 9:20** But they held their peace: for by the way they had disputed among

themselves, who *should be* the greatest.

**Matthew 27:3-5** **3**Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, **4**Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What *is that* to us? see thou *to that*. **5**And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

**Matthew 9:34** But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils through the prince of the devils.

**Matthew 25:41** Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:
